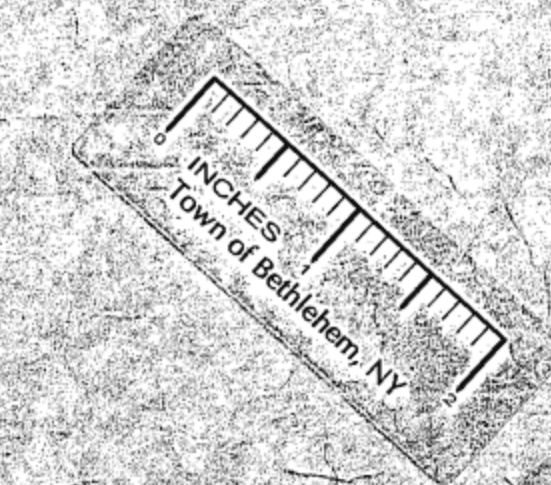

Has ~~unanimously~~ approved the street layout as shown on this plan under the following conditions: that the proposed new portion of Frederick St. shall be suitably graded and paved in accordance with standard specifications and procedure acceptable to the Town Board, and upon condition that a proposed new portion of Frederick St. (also an existing town street) be constructed from Brockley Street at its present intersection with Frederick St. (also an existing town street) and also upon condition that adequate disposal of sanitary wastes be provided and storm drains be installed in accordance with standards specified by the appropriate governmental authorities.
